ECS Statement of Faith

My signature on the last page signifies that our home meets the following criteria:

1. At least one parent or guardian is a professing follower of Jesus Christ. If one parent is not a professing follower of Christ, he or she understands, accepts and supports the school's Christian philosophy of education and will participate whenever possible.
2. At least one parent is an active member and weekly church attendee of a local Christian church which teaches and subscribes to the following:
 - a. The scriptures of the Old and New Testaments were given by the inspiration of God, and are the only sufficient, certain, and authoritative rule of all saving knowledge, faith and obedience.
 - b. There is but one God, the Maker, Preserver, and Ruler of all things; having in and of Himself all perfection, and being infinite in them all; and to Him all creatures owe the highest love, reverence, and obedience.
 - c. God is revealed to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, each being with distinct personal attributes, but without division of nature, essence, or being.
 - d. God from eternity decrees or permits all things that come to pass, and perpetually upholds, directs, and governs all creatures and all events, yet so as not in any wise to be the author or approver of sin nor to destroy the free will and responsibility of intelligent creatures.
 - e. Election is God's eternal choice of some persons unto everlasting life--not because of foreseen merit in them, but because of His mere mercy in Christ--in consequence of which choice they are called, justified, and glorified.
 - f. God originally created man in His own image, and free from sin; but through the temptation of Satan, man transgressed the command of God, and fell from his original holiness and righteousness; whereby his posterity inherits a nature corrupt and wholly opposed to God and His law, are under condemnation, and as soon as they are capable of moral action, become actual transgressors.
 - g. Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, is the divinely appointed mediator between God and man. Having taken upon Himself human nature, yet without sin, He perfectly fulfilled the law, suffered, and died upon the cross for the salvation of sinners. He was buried, and rose again the third day, and ascended to His Father, at whose right hand He ever liveth to make intercession for His people. He is the only Mediator, the Prophet, Priest, and King of the Church, and Sovereign of the universe.
 - h. Regeneration is a change of heart, wrought by the Holy Spirit, who quickeneth the dead in trespasses and sins, enlightening their minds spiritually and savingly to understand the Word of God, and renewing their whole nature, so that they love and practice holiness. It is a work of God's free and special grace alone.
 - i. Repentance is an evangelical grace, wherein a person being, by the Holy Spirit, made sensible of the manifold evil of his sin, humbleth himself for it, with godly sorrow, detestation of it, and self abhorrence, with a purpose and endeavor to walk with God so as to please Him in all things.
 - j. Saving faith is the belief, on God's authority, of whatsoever is revealed in His Word concerning Christ; accepting and resting upon Him alone for justification, sanctification, and eternal life. It is wrought in the heart by the Holy Spirit, and is accompanied by all other saving graces, and leads to a life of holiness.

- k. Justification is God's gracious and full acquittal of sinners, who believe in Christ, from all sin, through the satisfaction that Christ has made; not for anything wrought in them or done by them; but on account of the obedience and satisfaction of Christ, receiving and resting on Him and His righteousness by faith.
- l. Those who have been regenerated are also sanctified, by God's Word and Spirit dwelling in them. This sanctification is progressive through the supply of Divine strength, which all the saints seek to obtain, pressing after a heavenly life in cordial obedience to all Christ's commands.
- m. Those whom God hath accepted in the Beloved, and sanctified by His Spirit, will never totally nor finally fall away from the state of grace, but shall certainly persevere to the end; and though they may fall, through neglect and temptation, into sin, whereby they grieve the Spirit, impair their graces and comforts, bring reproach on the Church, and temporal judgments on themselves, yet they shall be renewed again unto repentance, and be kept by the power of God through faith unto salvation.
- n. The Lord Jesus is the Head of the church, which is composed of all His true disciples, and in Him is invested supremely all power for its government. According to His commandments, Christians are to unite with local churches; and to each of these churches He hath given needful authority for administering that order, discipline and worship which He hath appointed. The regular officers of a church are Pastors and Deacons.
- o. Baptism and The Lord's Supper are ordinances of the Lord Jesus, obligatory upon every believer, not for salvation, but for obedience and witness
- p. The Lord's Day is a Christian institution for regular observance, and should be employed in exercises of worship and spiritual devotion, both public and private, resting from worldly employments, works of necessity and mercy only accepted.
- q. God alone is Lord of the conscience; and He hath left it free from the doctrines and commandments of men, which are in anything contrary to His Word, or not contained in it. Civil magistrates being ordained of God, subjection in all lawful things commanded by them ought to be yielded by us in the Lord, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake.
- r. God hath appointed a day, wherein He will judge the whole world by Jesus Christ, when every one shall receive according to his deeds; the wicked shall go away into everlasting punishment; the righteous into everlasting life.

Standards of Conduct

Financial Obligations

- I understand that this re-enrollment contract cannot be considered complete, nor my child accepted, without the non-refundable registration fee.
- I understand that to reserve a place for my child both copies of the Enrollment Contract and the Registration Fee must be received by the Admissions Office no later than July 1, 2010.
- I understand that if I withdraw my student after June 1, 2010, I am responsible to pay the full tuition to the end of the academic year. In addition, a letter will be sent to those families whose tuition is in arrears after 30 days stating that all past due tuition, late charges and current month's tuition will be due within 30 days. If an account becomes 60 days delinquent, the school reserves the right to dismiss the student from school.
- In view of this obligation, I understand that the Tuition Refund Plan is being made available to me at this time to protect my yearly financial obligation under the terms of the Enrollment Contract. This program insures fees (prepaid and due) in the event of separation according to the terms of the policy. Tuition Insurance Guidelines

The school has many expenses of a continuing nature. In order for these services to be provided over the entire year, it is essential that the annual income from tuitions and fees be received. No reduction or remission of fees including, but not limited to, re-enrollment, activity fees, registration fees, tuition insurance or tuition payments will be made for absence, withdrawal or dismissal. Consequently, we have made arrangements to protect students under the Tuition Insurance Refund Plan.

This Plan will not only provide an allowance of tuition fees in the event of withdrawal of a student for medical causes but also in the event of withdrawal for other reasons or dismissal by the School (annual tuition charges, both prepaid and due, are insured). The Tuition Refund Plan becomes effective on August 1 in the event of the student's inability to attend school due to a covered medical reason. The non-medical coverage (voluntary withdrawals and dismissals) does not become effective until the student has attended fourteen consecutive calendar days (including weekends) commencing with the student's first class day of attendance in the academic year.

The cost is 2.9% of the annual tuition charges for the 2010/2011 academic year. Parents who do not pay the total annual charges by July 1, 2010 must participate in the Tuition Refund Plan or present evidence of having secured comparable insurance coverage elsewhere. Participation is elective for those who pay the total annual charge by July 1, 2010.

The School offers you the Tuition Refund Plan as a means to insure your annual financial obligation under the terms of the accompanying Enrollment Contract. **Please read the information regarding the Plan that appears in the Enrollment Contract and the Tuition Refund Plan brochure carefully and check either Box "A" or "B" on the Enrollment Contract.**

In light of the no refund or cancellation enrollment terms, we recommend that all parents in their own interest participate in the Plan.

PARENTS ARE REMINDED THAT NO REFUND OF FEES CAN BE MADE EXCEPT AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS PLAN. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT STUDENTS ARE ENROLLED FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL YEAR OR SUCH PORTION AS MAY REMAIN AFTER THE DATE OF ENTRANCE. THE FACT THAT THE SCHOOL FEES ARE PAID IN TWO OR MORE INSTALLMENTS DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A FRACTIONAL CONTRACT. COVERAGE UNDER THE PLAN IS CONTINGENT UPON PAYMENT OF THE INSURANCE CHARGE WITHIN TEN DAYS FROM THE FIRST CLASS DAY OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR

It is imperative that Box A or B below is checked for each child enrolled. **Note: Participation is required unless the full annual charges are paid by the opening day of School, in which case the Plan is elective.**

- A. I wish to participate in the Tuition Refund Plan. The premium rate is 2.9% of the annual fees. I authorize the School to process and collect any claim payment to which I am entitled under the Tuition Refund Plan and credit it to my account, paying any excess to me.
- B. I do not wish to participate in the Tuition Refund Plan. I understand that no refund or cancellation of the yearly fees will be made by the School for absence, withdrawal or dismissal before the end of the school year and herewith agree to assume full responsibility for the full annual fees.

I understand that in signing this Enrollment Contract for the coming academic year, I am agreeing to accept the rules and regulations of the School as stated in the current catalog and the rule concerning payment of fees as referred to above. Furthermore, I agree to the policy of the School that no student will be permitted to take examinations nor will grades and transcripts be released unless an account has been paid in full.

Enrollment, as specified within this Enrollment Contract, may be canceled by the parents or guardians in writing, without penalty (except forfeit of the Reservation Deposit) prior to August 1. If enrollment is canceled after August 1, parents or guardians financially responsible for the student are obligated to pay the full annual charges.
