Our Mission

We have a sincere love for children and a commitment to partner with families in educating their children to prepare them socially, emotionally, academically, and spiritually. K3 Curriculum/Program

At Emmanuel Christian Preschool, learning is more than a game. And to succeed in learning, you need the proper building blocks called curriculum. That’s why we use the “A Beka” curriculum for all grades. “A Beka” is a proven curriculum used by more Christian schools than any other.

At the heart of “A Beka” is an excellent phonics program used to develop superior reading skills. Beginning with the 3 year old level, they learn vowel and consonant sounds and recognition of lower and upper case letters.

K4 Curriculum/Program

By K-4 they will learn to blend phonic sounds, pronounce one and two vowel words and read through as many as 10 books. In addition to writing skills they, develop language and listening skills that include color words, shapes, animals, transportation, countries, community helpers, health, safety, manners and science. Twenty eight poems and finger plays are committed to memory and they will learn their numbers 1-100 and basic addition facts. Reading groups in the spring strengthen school readiness skills.

Learning Activities

The K3/K4 Preschool students at ECS participate in a variety of Learning Activities: chapel, art, music, recess, crafts, creative play, field trips create within the child an excitement for learning. Parents have the option of full or half day programs on a three or five day schedule. Our beautiful, modern playground located on the property allows students to enjoy the outdoors in a safe and secure environment.

Extended Care

The regular school day for a full day student is from 8am – 3pm daily. Students may arrive as early as 6:30am and stay until 6pm in our extended care program for an additional hourly charge.

Hot lunch is offered daily and is prepared in our modern, state certified kitchen. Students may also pack a lunch and purchase milk or juice.

Summer care is offered from June through August through our Summer Camp program. Parents can sign up for the entire summer or by the week as needed.
